Over the course of the past few months, Network and Computer Services has phased in network and security controls to further secure our internal networks. These updates affect devices that are physically connected to the network, including desktop computers, laptops connected to docking stations, network

printers, and other devices reliant on a physical connection. The updates have been implemented to prevent malicious devices and insecure or unknown devices from directly connecting to and accessing our internal and private networks.

Though the changes are intended to be transparent, there is always the potential that a computer or device may fail the security checks.
