REMINDER: TIMESHEETS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON SNAP BY WEDNESDAY: December 20, 2017 BY 9:00 AM MT

Please note with the early deadline in combination with the Holiday, processing time for the December payroll will be condensed. That said, missed timesheet submissions or approvals may cause a delay in pay so be mindful of the deadline!

Hourly employees and student workers should always record all actual hours worked. There are 176 hours in this current pay period, including 8 hours of HOL pay for November 23rd and 8 hours of ADM pay for November 24th.

BHSU announces \$32 million Capital Campaign for student scholarships and campus advancement

Black Hills State University has announced its record-breaking goal of raising \$32 million through a Capital Campaign for student scholarships and campus advancement. The campaign has raised \$23.7 million since July 2014 and has already provided for 46 new scholarship endowments. BHSU aims to complete the Capital Campaign by December 2019.
