**Affective factors in learning workshop**

From University of Seville, Spain, Dr. Jane Arnold will be presenting two workshops at BHSU campus related to affective factors in learning process. Please feel free to join it.

**-Workshop I, Wed, April 4th | JA 307 | 2 - 4pm**

Dr. Arnold will share how positive group dynamics stimulate interaction and learning and will guide participants through diverse practical applications for fostering positive learning communities within their classrooms. We will see diverse practical applications for working with the group dynamics in our classrooms.

**-Workshop II, Thurs, April 5th | JA 307 | 2 - 4pm**

This workshop will examine how individual factors, such as motivation, self-esteem and autonomy can have a significant influence on learning and how attention to these factors can provide meaning and incentive for learners. Applications for the classroom from Howard Gardner's Theory of Multiple Intelligences will be explored. With the visual-spatial intelligence we will see how the use in class of art and other visual elements and of mental imagery can be beneficial in general and specifically for language learning.
