Black Hills State University students raise \$2340 for childcare center in Soweto South Africa.

BHSU students enrolled in the International Service Learning course this semester raised \$2340.00 for a childcare center in Soweto South Africa. The childcare center owner, Hendricks, built the childcare center himself on what used to be a garbage dump. He has devoted his life to creating a safe, educational environment for the young children of this area. Up to this point he has put his own money and efforts into the construction and upkeep of the facility.

The money raised is the equivalent to year's wages in Soweto. Hendricks indicated that part of the money would be used to put toilets in for the children.

In March, over spring break, BHSU students personally presented the day care center with the money raised while on their Service Learning to trip to Botswana Africa.
