REMINDER: TIMESHEETS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON SNAP BY TUESDAY: November 21, 2017

BY 9:00 AM MT

Please note with the early deadline in combination with the Holiday, processing time for the November payroll will be condensed. That said, missed timesheet submissions or approvals may cause a delay in pay so be mindful of the deadline! Hourly employees and student workers should always record all actual hours worked. There are 176 hours in this current pay period, including 8 hours of HOL pay for November 10th.

Supervisors - all timesheets must be approved BY 2 PM TUESDAY as processes start that afternoon. Prior to approving any timesheets please check the leave request systems for outstanding leave requests. Once the leave is approved the timesheet should be updated with the appropriate leave and approved for processing. Please note, if the timesheet approval deadline is missed, your employee(s) will experience a delay in receiving a paycheck.

BHSU-Rapid City to offer block scheduling option in spring 2018; students complete class in 18 day blocks

This spring, Black Hills State University-Rapid City will become the first South Dakota university to offer this type of block scheduling. Seven block courses will be offered during the 2018 spring semester. Each class will run for 18 consecutive business days, taking place from either 9 a.m.-12 p.m. or 1-4 p.m. each day for the entire block. A scholarship is available for students taking the new block course and will provide \$100 per block for up to \$400 per semester. The University will continue offering daytime and evening classes in the traditional semester-long format, along with the new block schedule option.

BHSU named a Bicycle Friendly University by the League of American Bicyclists

Today, the League of American Bicyclists recognized Black Hills State University with a Bronze Bicycle Friendly UniversitySM (BFUSM) award. BHSU is the only university in South Dakota with this designation.

Army ROTC student to represent BHSU in Army All American Bowl

Cadet Tate Jackson, a sociology major at Black Hills State University from Parmelee, has been selected for the U.S. Army All American Bowl and Combine as a Cadet Marshall in San Antonio, Texas, in January. Jackson was chosen out of more than 6,000 applicants because of his leadership abilities, dedication to community service and maintaining a 3.9 GPA as a sociology major.

BHSU Geek Speak to examine mathematical problem worth \$1 million

Dr. Parthasarathi Nag, professor of mathematics, will discuss the famous Riemann's Hypothesis, a mathematical problem that has remained unsolved for over 150 years and is worth \$1 million, during the BHSU Geek Speak lecture Thursday, Nov. 16 at 4 p.m. in Jonas Hall, room 110 in Spearfish.
