Fall 2017 Course Drop/Withdrawal Deadline

Friday, November 3 is the deadline to drop full semester length classes (short-term classes have different deadlines). Undergraduate courses dropped by the withdrawal deadline will be assigned a grade of "WD" and there will be no tuition credit. "WD" grades do not affect your GPA. You are allowed a maximum of six WD's, over the course of your undergraduate work.

Graduate courses can also be dropped for a "W" grade, with no effect to the GPA and no tuition credit.

After November 3, no withdrawals will be allowed. Grades must be assigned per

instructor record.
