Abstract:

Using a process called Saggar firing, I am able to create unique surface treatments on the vessels I create on the potter's wheel. The process involves a lidded container used to contain and isolate pots during saggar firing. Different chemicals are added to the fire to create different colors and textures to the vessels. Saggar firing allows me to create pieces of artwork that never turns out the same. Each piece has its own characteristics and this is why I enjoy the process, because relating it to life the outcome will always be unknown. My artwork is a reflection of my life and family, my ceramic vessels are portraits of people close to me. Their characteristics are carved into clay metaphorically through technique and texture. My father can no longer work and is partially paralyzed due to a stroke, while my mother suffers from a progressive disease called Huntington's disease. Knowing that I may carry the gene frightens me, so I must rely on ceramic art and its natural ability to escape reality for a moment in time. Ceramic art is my passion and it gives me confidence to express my creativity from my life events.
