Join us for our first Geek Speak of spring! These weekly lectures are free and open to the public. On January 14 at 4:00 p.m. in Jonas 110, Professor Ann Porter will present, "Stuffies, Sex and the Contemporary Counter-Reformation."

This presentation will use visual images to investigate the idea of a contemporary Counter-Reformation. Like the Counter-Reformation initiated by the Catholic church to guard against the perceived heresy of Protestantism, so the cultural conservatism of the 1950's, when challenged by the explorations of the 1960's, created a conservative backlash that is still with us today. Examples of this phenomenon will range from Lassie, Barbie and Willem de Kooning to Hello Kitty, Mike Kelly and Furry Conventions.
