Two BHSU athletic teams are headed to DII championship competitions this week creating a March madness atmosphere on campus and throughout the region. The BHSU women's basketball team made history when they were selected for the University's first-ever Division II national tournament. The team, which finished the season ranked fifth, received an at-large bid to the "big dance." Five track team members qualified for the Indoor Track and Field NCAA Division II indoor national championships. They will compete in shot put and weight throw, the mile run, and the distance medley.
