2. **Application fee procedural guidelines for returning and non-degree seeking students:**
 - If you have attended a Regental university (Black Hills State University, University of South Dakota, South Dakota State University, Northern State University, Dakota State University, South Dakota School of Mines & Technology) within the previous three terms, (including summer), your \$20 application fee will be waived. If your attendance at a Regental university was not within the previous three terms, you will be required to pay the \$20 application fee.
 - Non-Degree Seeking students are not required to pay the \$20 application fee.

Admission Requirements

Returning students must have a 2.0 (C) grade point average. Students not meeting the 2.0 GPA admission requirement may be considered for admission on academic probation.

Non-degree seeking students are not required to send high school or previous college, university, or technical school transcripts.
