

While attending Northern State University, she participated in the Maryland Research Experience for Undergraduates (REU) and was able to live on Solomon's Island, Maryland for a summer conducting research on the bioavailability of flame retardants found in wastewater streams. It was through this REU program where she discovered her passion for water treatment and through the advice of her mentors she returned to South Dakota and enrolled at South Dakota School of Mines and Technology. Erin graduated with a Master's Degree in Civil Engineering – Environmental Emphasis in 2010 and began her career with the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR) as an engineer.
