MISSING SPOUSE/DEPENDENT SSN

On Monday, April 15th, an email will be sent to employees from BHRMEMBERBENEFITS asking for SSNs for spouses and/or dependents that currently do not have valid SSNs in GHR/INFOR. The good news is that if an employee's spouse/dependent will never have an SSN, we have identified those, so those employees will not get an email. This information will also be in Jesse Merkel's weekly communication update.

This is a legitimate email, and here's what the email will say: Subject Line: Important Information About Your Benefits

A recent audit of our records indicated that you have one or more dependents with a missing or invalid Social Security Number in our Human Resources Information System. Social Security Numbers are required for compliance with the Affordable Care Act for any covered members on the health plan, as well as to provide eligibility and coverage files to certain benefit vendors.

Dependent spouses without a valid Social Security Number in our HRIS system will not be able to access the well-being portal.

Please call the Bureau of Human Resources and Administration at 605.773.3148 to provide this information.

If your dependent will never have a Social Security Number, please call us and let us know, as we can identify this in our system and therefore, you will not receive future communications to update your record.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR FY 2025

The Mileage Reimbursement and In-State Lodging Reimbursement rates will increase on July 1, 2024 and are outlined below. There are no other changes to meals or out-of-state/out-of country reimbursements.

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Effective July 1, 2024, the maximum in-state lodging reimbursement rate will increase to be consistent with the actual cost of in-state lodging, not to exceed the rate set by the General Service Administration (GSA). The standard rate of \$107 per night will apply to travel in all counties in South Dakota, except for those specifically listed by the GSA. The lodging reimbursement rate for out-of-state and out-of-country travel will not change from the current rate of \$175 per night, with an additional \$100 available with excess lodging approval.

ALL Offices must remain open and covered Monday - Friday 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Normal hours resume August 19.

Flex time options (supervisors may work with employees):

- Four 10-hour days during the week. Day off to be determined by employee and supervisor.
- Four 9-hour days Monday Thursday + Friday morning from 7:30-11:30.
- Four normal days (7:30-4:30) + remote work on fifth day (7:30-4:30).

Options can be approved for some weeks (but not all) summer months. For example, July - work alternative schedule for two weeks/work normal schedule for other two weeks.

Schedules require supervisor's approval. Offices must be open and coverage is a must. Small offices may partner with other offices so all have the ability to take advantage of summer hours.

Reminder: Flex time may impact hourly timesheets. Make sure you have all hours listed for the month per the timesheet reminders HR puts in the e-update the week before payroll.
