Specific Education Undergraduate Requirements	Ac 302.02 CPA Certificate Applicant Education (3) Applicants for certification on or after July 1, 2014, shall have at least a baccalaureate degree that includes at least 120 hours pursuant to Ac 302.02 (f) from an educational institution accredited pursuant to Ac 302.02 (b), and an additional 30 semester hours of education which shall meet the criteria in Ac 302.02. The total required semester hours of education shall consist of not less than 30 hours in accounting and 24 hours in business courses accredited pursuant to 302.02(b). (b) An educational institution shall be considered by the board to be accredited if (1) Approved by a member of a regional or national accrediting agency that is recognized by the United States Department of Education; or (2) Approved by the American Assembly of Collegiate Schools (AACSB).
