


## Connecting to BHSU-Secure Network for Android

1. Choose the "BHSU-Secure" wireless network.
2. Leave the "EAP Method" option set to PEAP.
3. Leave "Phase 2 Authentication" set to None.
4. Under "CA Certificate" choose "Do not validate" or leave as "(Unspecified)"
5. Under "Identity" enter your email address. For example, jane.smith@bhsu.edu.
6. Leave the "Anonymous Identity" option blank.
7. Enter your password in the "Password" field. The password should match your normal email password.
8. Click the "Connect" button. You should now be successfully connected to the BHSU-Secure network.
