

Our Purpose

The South Dakota Board of Regents is offering week-long career exploration camps on campuses for incoming 7th and 8th grade students in Summer 2025. This is a FREE camp thanks to a grant by the South Dakota Department of Education, the South Dakota Board of Technical Education, and the South Dakota Board of Regents!

Campers will be immersed in a week of "college life" designed to explore career paths through engaging activities and tours of area business and industry. By the end of this five-day residential camp, students will have a better understanding of themselves, their personal career interests, and how education connects to these professions.

Campers Will Experi<mark>ence:</mark>

- Exposure to <u>23 career paths</u> through hands-on learning.
- A full day and two half-days at Black Hills State University.
- A day trip to Western Dakota Technical College.
- A day trip to South Dakota School of Mines and Technology.
- Afternoon tours of area business and industry.
- Transportation to and from off-campus field trip sites.
 - Transportation is being provided by Dakota Bus Service, Inc. Dakota Trailways Bus Charter
- On-campus housing (four overnights) in BHSU's Bordeaux Residence Hall.
 - Night Resident Assistants are on call.
- Campus dining facilities (all meals, snacks, and drinks included).

WHAT TO BRING


