(1) Education requirements: Effective July 1, 2000, to apply for the CPA examination you must have completed: (a) At least one hundred fifty semester hours (two hundred twenty-five quarter hours) of college education, including; (b) A baccalaureate or higher degree; and (c) An accounting major or concentration as defined as at least: (i) Twenty-four semester hours (thirty-six quarter hours) or the equivalent in accounting subjects of which at least fifteen semester hours must be at the upper level or graduate level (an upper level course is defined as a course that frequently carries completion of a lower level course(s) as a prerequisite); and (ii) Twenty-four semester hours (thirty-six quarter hours) or the equivalent in business administration subjects at the undergraduate or graduate level.
