4. President's Report

- a. Received a "do pass" on the following funding requests to the legislature:
 - i. West River Science Center addition \$8,000,000
 - ii. Science education mobile lab \$78,000
 - iii. Multi-media lab for communications studies major \$112,500
 - iv. Ellsworth Airforce Base campus startup funding \$209,080
- b. Bill awaits the Governor's signature to allow the BOR to set tuition rates for Rapid City and Sioux Falls campuses.
- c. Joint committee of the legislature approved a letter of intent for the BOR to study allocation formula for funding BOR universities. This is the first step towards changing current funding allocations.

5. Distinguished Faculty Update

a. Discussed changing the letter of support requirement for Distinguished Faculty nomination.
